Need to Know

We are a *NUT FREE* school as we have students and staff who have life-threatening allergies. This includes Nutella.

Safe Arrival Program (Report an Absence):

We offer a safe arrival program. If parents have not called the school to notify us of the absence, an automated call will be placed at 9:00 am to inform parents.

We request that parents contact the school in the morning if your child is going to be absent.

Need to Know



Policy 701 - Health Concerns:

Inform your child's teacher or the school of any specific health concerns. If your child requires medication to be administered, forms must be completed. These forms are available at the office. We cannot administer any medication without this form.

Parking and Drop Off Zone:

- You may drop your child off in the front of the school in the designated area (kiss and drop style). Please, no parking in the drop off area. <u>Families are not permitted</u> on the playground (for safety reasons).
- Bell rings for school to start at 8:20 am.
- If your child arrives late, they must be buzzed in at the front doors of the school. Once students have settled in September, we ask that your child comes in alone and goes to their class.

Student Safety

Your child's safety is our top priority. We have approximately 400 students who sometimes move independently through the halls. In order to keep them safe from strangers, we ask that you do not come into the building without an appointment. If you do not have an appointment, but need access to your child, please ring the front doorbell, and let our office staff know and they will call your child down to the office. Student Fee / Supplies:

- \$55.00 student fee (due as soon as possible).
- This student fee helps purchase school supplies for your child throughout the year.

We also ask that you supply:

- box of large Ziploc bags
- box of tissues
- luggage tag (attached to backpack) with after school information



Indoor Footwear/Outdoor Footwear:

- Pair of indoor sneakers for the classroom and Physical Education
- Easy for your child to put on and take off independently.
- If they are not yet tying laces, <u>slip-on or velcro closing sneakers are required</u>.
- Please label all belongings.





Extra Clothing and Labeling

- Extra **full change** of clothes (socks, underwear, shirt, pants).
- <u>Kept inside a Ziploc bag. This will stay in your child's bookbag</u> all year.
- Check frequently in case they need a new change of clothes (stains, wet, bathroom accidents etc.).
- Clothing that is easy for them to put on independently.

The Anglophone West School District and its schools are required to comply with legislation which protects students' personal information, in particular the Education Act, the Right to Information and Protection of Privacy Act ((RTIPPA) and the Personal Health Information Privacy and Access Act (PHIPPA). Parents/guardians of students under the age of 18 must be informed of how personal information is used and to give permission for those uses. Throughout the school year, student information may be used and disclosed for a variety of purposes (e.g., academic achievement, student celebrations, school photos). Yes, my child's name and/or photo may be listed publicly throughout the school in classroom,
administration and recognition boards in the school. Examples: classroom names on cubicles, hooks
etc., honor roll recognition boards in hallways, etc.
Yes, my child may participate in performing arts, scholastic competitions, athletic events, or other
school-related events that are videoed or livestreamed.



Notes:

- 1. Students involved in performing arts, scholastic competitions or athletic activities perform or compete in public venues, including school. It is reasonable to expect that photographs or videos may be taken by spectators and the media. Once parents/guardians or other members of the public are invited, the event becomes a public event and anyone in attendance is allowed to take photographs or videos without first obtaining consent. Visitors are reminded to be respectful of other individual's privacy, but the school is not able to control the images captured in these situations and the images may be shared by that person on social media sites.
- Video surveillance equipment may be used in schools to enhance the safety of students and staff, to protect property and to aid in the identification of intruders or other persons who may pose a risk to school community members.
